In Year 8, students will build on key vocabulary and grammatical concepts seen in Year 7. Students will continue to develop and improve their skills in speaking, listening, reading and writing, so that by the end of Year 8, they will have improved confidence and proficiency in producing both spoken and written Spanish. Furthermore, they will increase their knowledge of vocabulary relating to wider topics to enable them to give more detailed, justified opinions in a range of tenses.
