OVERVIEW

Following the Albion Academy curriculum for Religious Education pupils in Year 8 will study 3 religious traditions. Firstly, the teaching of Islam will complete the study of all of the Abrahmic Faiths, building on knowledge from year 7. Students will then explore two of the Dharmic traditions Hindusim and Sikhism. Understanding a range of opinions and perspectives on such questions will lead to an increase in tolerance, acceptance and respect for the local and wider community and a general acceptance that we as British Citizens have the right to practice whichever religion we choose without discrimination.

Assessment:

Students in Y8 will continue to be assessed using both formative and summative methods. Students will be continually assessed lesson using questioning feedback and independent practice. Additionally, they will be assessed through 'Big Writes' and end of unit tasks. This will assess students' knowledge and understanding and develop students' explanation skills. Towards the end of year students will have an End of Year assessment, in which they will be assessed on knowledge gained through the year, this will be applied to both descriptive and explanatory style questions.
