Students will study the Tudor religious rollercoaster and explore the significant changes that occurred as the pendulum swung from Catholicism to Protestantism and back again. They will consider the religious changes under Elizabeth and explore its impact on different groups. Students will also explore the Industrial Revolution and consider how much progress was made. They will begin to analyse positive and negative changes to different groups and explore the nature of change and continuity. Students will explore how England changed from a monarch to Republic to Commonwealth in the Stuart period. They will consider the changes in power between the monarch and parliament and its lasting impact today.
