Seneca is an online platform that contains courses of knowledge and skills for a wide range of subjects. Teachers assign Seneca courses to their classes. These are linked to KS3 skills and specific GCSE exam board criteria. Students can access these linked courses whenever they want for consolidation or revision.

Teachers can also set specific parts of courses as homework assignments for students to complete. This is most commonly used for History and Geography.

It contains a range of interactive activities to engage students with reviewing key concepts and vocabulary. Students can see instantly whether they got the answer correct. It also provides useful data to teachers about where a student or a class has a knowledge gap so that this can be reviewed in future lessons.

Supporting with Seneca

Review your child's progress with them. If you see that they got less than 80% on a section, encourage them to have another go at it. You can also guide your child to individual revision on this platform in the run up to assessments.
