Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope this message finds you well.

As we are expecting particularly warm weather tomorrow and Friday, I wanted to take a moment to reassure you that we are mindful of the conditions and will be taking appropriate steps to ensure the wellbeing of all our students throughout the days.

However, at the start of the day when the weather is cooler we will be maintaining our usual uniform standards, which includes wearing ties and blazers to come to school. We believe that upholding our dress code supports the high standards and sense of respect we value as a school community.

We may well move to allowing students to remove ties and blazers fully over the day as it warms, and we always allow our students to remove blazers in class if the teacher is politely asked, regardless of the weather.

Please ensure your child brings a water bottle to stay hydrated. We have multiple water filters around the school which children can use before school, at designated break times and at lunch times to fill up free of charge. In addition, we also have free orange and blackcurrant squash at lunchtimes for all students.

Finally, we will be making other adjustments where necessary, such as providing access to shaded areas during breaks and ensuring classrooms are as well-ventilated as possible with use of air conditioning in classrooms and areas where it exists. To support us further, we also encourage the application of sunscreen before school on these warm days.
