Dear Parents, Carers and Students,

I hope this letter finds you well. I write with some important information for you about the Half Term break and for when we return on Monday 3rd June at 8:25am.

Attendance and Absence

High attendance at school is a must for children. Absence from school will stop your child from getting good GCSEs with us. This will affect them for the rest of their lives. Our minimum expectation for your child to do well with us is that your child's attendance will be 95% and their absence at 5%. Over a half term this looks like:

- Your child will only have 1.5 days a half term off maximum
- Your child will then miss a maximum of **7 lessons** per half term

Uniform Standards

We have clear standards of uniform at the Academy. Our Form Tutors and Heads of Year check these daily at our line ups. The majority of children follow our uniform policy but there are a minority who come to school not wearing the correct uniform.

If you do need support and things are difficult please do contact us at contact@albionacademy.co.uk so we can help to see whether you may qualify for Free School Meals.


